



Advancing Digital Health Innovations for Evidence-Based Care for Diabetes and Hypertension

We are pleased to share that the Clinical Decision Support System (CDSS) initiative, developed through a collaboration between the All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), New Delhi, Centre for Chronic Disease Control (CCDC), and ClinAlly, has been recognized at the AP MedTech Innovation Challenge, an initiative supported by the Government of Andhra Pradesh to identify and promote scalable healthcare innovations.

The challenge received 297 applications from HealthTech and MedTech innovators, of which 18 promising solutions were selected for real-world pilot implementation in public healthcare settings across Andhra Pradesh. As part of this initiative, the CDSS was piloted at the District Hospital, Parvathipuram, focusing on strengthening evidence-based management of hypertension and diabetes.

Following the pilot implementation, shortlisted innovators presented their solutions and learnings to healthcare leaders, technical experts, and government representatives. Our partner, ClinAlly received the 2nd Runner-Up Award for the CDSS innovation, presented by Hon'ble Shri Satya Kumar Yadav, Minister of Health, Family Welfare and Medical Education, Government of Andhra Pradesh.

The National Health Authority (NHA), Government of India, has supported the CDSS initiative by enabling its deployment and integration with ABDM-compliant digital health platforms, facilitating wider adoption of evidence-based clinical decision support within the national digital health ecosystem.

The CDSS initiative aims to translate clinical evidence into practical digital tools that support healthcare providers in delivering standardized, guideline-based care for non-communicable diseases. The platform is also integrated with the NIC NextGen eHospital platform, creating opportunities for broader adoption within public health systems.

This recognition highlights the value of collaborative innovation involving clinical experts, public health researchers, government partners, and technology teams in developing scalable solutions for strengthening healthcare delivery.

We congratulate ClinAlly and acknowledge the contributions of all partners involved in advancing digital health innovations for improving NCD care.

We thank the Government of Andhra Pradesh, Andhra Pradesh MedTech Zone, healthcare providers, and all collaborators for supporting innovations that can improve healthcare delivery at scale.
